# Co-mingled Recycling Program



### I want to be RECYCLED:

Plastics: bottles, tubs, lids, packaging

-If it's stamped with the recycling symbol recycle it! The number within the symbol describes the type of plastic.

Cans: aluminum, steel/tin, aerosol cans

Paper: magazines, junk mail, office paper, newspaper, catalogs, phone books, envelopes (windows ok), paper grocery bags

Paperboard

Cardboard boxes (flat),

including empty pizza boxes

Cartons: milk-style cartons

Styrofoam (no packing peanuts)

#### Tips:

- -Lids can be recycled too. Separate them from the bottle/container.
- -Give food-contaminated materials a quick **rinse** to avoid odor issues.

Glass: trash

Foil: trash

Juice boxes or pouches: trash

Packing peanuts: recycle at Goin' Postal or

Ship It Postal Service

Plastic bags: accepted at many grocery stores


Electronics: recycle at Pacific Steel; CRTs


accepted for a fee


CFLs (pigtail bulbs): recycle at Home Depot
